III. Presentation on Trauma Intervention Program (TIP)

- **What does the program intel?**
 - Basic volunteer training. The training consists of a two (2) week course, four (4) classes a week, and fifty-five (55) hours of training.
 - The individuals that are training will learn the following:
 - Emotional first aid.
 - Procedures for law enforcement, fire department, and other clients.
 - How to stay safe when they are out on the field.
- **What is an individual signing up for when they receive the TIP training?**

- When an individual gets the TIP training, they are agreeing to three (3) twelve (12) hour shifts and one educational training per month.
 - **Important things to keep in mind about TIP**
 - Calls are not always disclosed. Sometimes, there is only limited information given.
 - Funding comes from the cities where the program is currently being provided, fundraisers, and grants.
 - There are sub-chapters with TIP.
