



Culturally Responsive Therapy for Black Clients

- 1. Routinely reflect on your clinical decision-making
- 2. Affirm racial identity and lived experiences
- 3. Use strengths-based and liberation psychology approaches
- 4. Incorporate storytelling and expressive writing techniques
- 5. Consider historical and systemic trauma
- Expand the role of therapy beyond the individual
- 7. Utilize somatic approaches
- 8. Incorporate Acceptance and Commitment-Based Therapy techniques
- 9. Evaluate racial socialization practices
 - a) Integrating Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) and Racial Socialization for Black Youth and Families: An Implementation Manual

Methodological Considerations

- 1. Utilize qualitative and mixed-methods approaches
- 2. Incorporate Community-Based Participatory Action Research (CBPR)
- 3. Develop Youth Advisory Boards to inform program development and implementation
