### c. Development of videos in the summer

- i. Dr. Sullivan selected some videos and has requested permission to use the content but has yet to hear back from them.
- ii. Starting the video process with the Riverside County's team like Dylan Colt or RCC digital media team.
- iii. Create a de-escalating a crisis video that follows the Directing Change template.
- iv. With an advance notice, Dylan from the Media and Marketing team can film and edit the video.
- v. The subcommittee will oversee creating the script and getting the actors in place.
- vi. Dylan can meet the subcommittee on a campus or at Rustin to film the video.
- vii. Creating a script can be a challenge for the subcommittee.
- viii. Dylan could possibly travel to all campuses to record so it's not only the UCR background and that way each committee member has a piece of video content. At the same time being mindful that the script should be divided and use the meeting time as a space to develop the script.
- ix. A neutral location may be a good option for filming. For those that are located a little further with an advance notice committee members can plan ahead and drive to the neutral location. Members can represent their college with a t-shirt that represents their college, so all members look uniform.
- x. If members don't have the capacity to travel Dyaln could film virtually.
- xi. Dylan is a team of one so traveling to all campuses may be challenging.
- xii. UCR is happy to host the subcommittee for filming. Dr. Marmolejo and Dr. Saawf will be providing lunch and parking.
- xiii. Universities and community colleges should be paired together to show an alliance.
