III. Data Review- Suicide in Riverside County

- Deaths in RC to suicide: 2017 (276) 2018 (253) 2019(257)
- 2020 has seen an increase in wellness checks, informal data.
- Increase in deaths by suicide within the (10-14) age group. 2019 (0.9%) 2020 (3.2%)
- The 10-14 age group may be experiencing a lack of protective factors due to COVID 19.
- Seniors in RC also have a high percentage of deaths in RC. Over 30 percent consistently throughout the past couple of years.
- Seniors are possibly lacking engagement in senior facilities. They need SUPPORT WITH ACCESS. Telephone booth for senior residents?
- We can reach out to universities and high schools as they have requirements for community service.
- PSA's on coping skills, different stages. (TIK TOK)
- Using social media for our younger groups.
- Virtual support group that focuses on developmental stages, addressing these stages, social/emotional skills, physical limitations and looking at ways to help with this process.

- For our younger groups utilize directing change and other social media platforms such as TIK TOK.
- Male adults have higher percentage of suicide deaths in RC. White male have the highest percentage of deaths.
- Significant increases of suicide deaths within the African American and Asian population.
- Race/Ethnicity (10-14) Hispanic, African Americana and the Asian population having the highest percentage of deaths by suicide.
- Western County having the highest percentages of deaths by suicide.
