- Maybe do a presentation at a senior center for the staff so that they can be aware of the at-risk older adults and try and gain people to join our committee.
- Multi Tier approach, provide education and training to senior center staff, then we can
  connect to organizations that serve the senior population and then we can create
  material or provide materials that are already available to help at risk populations and
  have them posted at these sites, Then we can create a "senior corner" so we can have a
  designated area where we can have these materials regarding mental health with tips
  and resources they can connect with.
- Set up a schedule on a quarterly basis with these organizations so the information comes out on a consistent basis and create new forms of this information, so people are constantly looking at it.
- Find a way to distribute kindness kits to seniors that have universal items to give out. (Stuffed animals, slippers, socks, gloves, hand sanitizer, sudoku/crossword books, reading books, pj's, blankets)
- Use kindness kit idea but make it Upstream, add self-care items (Stuffed animal, battery operated fans, hand sanitizer, add information and resources)

- Get different agencies to help with co-branding so we can show a coordinated effort amongst all of us
- Bags with something specific for this initiative, Lynda can try and split costs/donations to purchase bags for this initiative.
- Deliver these kindness kits all year long?
